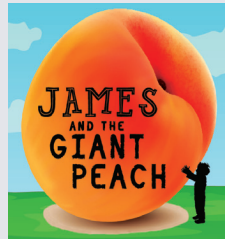

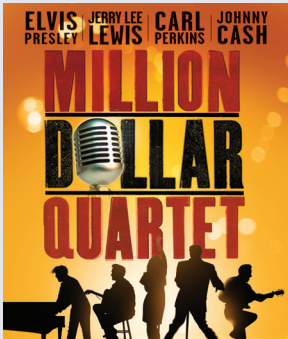
## MAKING GOD LAUGH

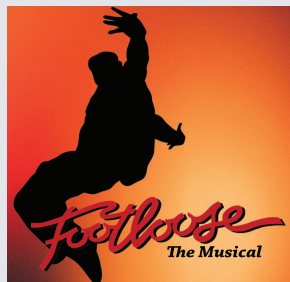


## GUYS ON ICE: THE ICE FISHING MUSICAL
